He is on the faculty of the Harvard School of Medicine

Joining Dr. Silversin is **Ms. Deborah Borda, the President and CEO of the Los Angeles Philharmonic and Hollywood Bowl**. She will present her experience is leading the LA Philharmonic through a time of significant change, and draw parallels between managing a symphony (with highly trained, autonomous musicians) to medicine (with highly trained, autonomous physicians).
